

Nicholas J R Haddock MBE MA FRGS was educated at St Edward's School and St Edmund Hall, Oxford, where he read Geography and played hockey for the University.

After leaving Oxford, he was commissioned as an officer in the Royal Green Jackets, where he attained the rank of Major. In 1998, he was awarded the MBE for work involved in planning military operations worldwide and was selected for promotion to Lieutenant Colonel, but instead left to pursue a career in teaching.

Mr Haddock took over as Headmaster of St John's School in September 2004.

He was previously a Housemaster at Cranleigh School and has also been Deputy Leader of an expedition sponsored by the Royal Geographical Society to Patagonian Chile and the Antarctic.
